Educating the public about child abuse and neglect

[Ontario's Children's Aid Societies](#) continue to educate the public about everyone's responsibility to protect children by reporting suspected child abuse as 27,000 children suffered some form of abuse or neglect last year. During the Child Abuse Prevention Campaign in October, the public is reminded that "kids shouldn't have to live with abuse" because everyone has a responsibility to act when they see or hear that a child is suffering from abuse or neglect.
